## Notice To Participants, Parents & Guardians

Rising Stars Sports Association (RSSA) - an insured 501(c)(3) - is dedicated to providing safe facilities and equipment for all participants in all activities. I understand that as a participant in Rising Stars Sports Association activities, my child is responsible for the proper use and care of all equipment and facilities that are used to host practices, games, tournaments or any other RSSA event. Rising Stars Sports Association, it's Coaches, Directors or Coordinators - along with Columbia Public Schools - ( or any site we play at or in ) assume no liability nor responsibility ( legally or financially ) for any loss of personal property, bodily injuries, or the result there of incurred and suffered by the applicant or those in attendance on any property as a result of an RSSA activity. It is understood that all sporting activities are of a physical nature and do involve some risk which is an assumed risk by the participants. In the event of a serious accident or illness, it is the policy of RSSA activity coordinators to: 1. contact the Emergency Dispatch ( 911 ) to perform first aid and when necessary recommend transport of the victim to a hospital; 2. contact the parent(s) or guardian(s) as soon as the situation allows. Persons desiring a different procedure must notify Rising Stars Sports Association in writing. Parents or Guardians who do not sign this waiver must be in attendance at the event in order for their child to participate.

**NOTE:** By signing this waiver you also understand that the uniform provided to your child is the property of Rising Stars Sports Association. The uniform shall be 1. kept in a presentable manner equal to the condition in which it was given to the player 2. returned to RSSA. If the uniform does not meet these two criteria, the uniform shall be purchased at cost from RSSA.

I will expect that my child's coach be considerate of individuality while balancing life-skills and sports skills. They should lead by example and display character by being respectful but yet challenging each child.

I will do everything in my power to insure that my child, his/her coach, and myself comply with the understanding that youth sports should be FUN and educational.
